1. WELCOME

The Catalan Federation of Sports for People with Physical Disabilities is pleased to invite clubs and athletes to take part in the **2x2 Open Power Wheelchair Hockey Tournament**, which will be held on **Saturday 14th and Sunday 15th February 2026** in the town of **Besalú (Girona, Spain)**.

This tournament aims to promote the practice of power wheelchair hockey in a 2x2 format, fostering inclusion, sporting interaction, and exchange between Catalan, national, and international athletes in a competitive yet accessible and participatory environment.

2. COMPETITION DATES AND SCHEDULE

- **Saturday, 14th February 2026**

Competition throughout the day: morning and afternoon.

- **Sunday, 15th February 2026**

Competition during the morning, including finals and closing ceremony

The final match schedule and timetable will be communicated once the registration period has closed.

3. COMPETITION VENUE

The tournament will take place at the **Besalú Municipal Sports Hall**, an accessible sports facility for power wheelchair users.

4. COMPETITION FORMAT

- Discipline: 2x2 Powerchair Hockey
- Open competition for athletes:
 - Local athletes (Catalonia)
 - National athletes (rest of Spain)
 - International

The competition system (group stage, round-robin, knockouts, or mixed format) will be defined according to the number of registered teams, ensuring the maximum number of matches for all participants

5. RULES

The competition will follow a simplified set of rules adapted to the 2x2 format, inspired by the Power Wheelchair Hockey (IPCH) regulations, with some modifications:

- **Teams:** 2 players per team: one T-stick player and one H-stick player.
- **Match duration:** 2 × 10 minutes of running time. The clock will only stop in case of major interruptions.
- **Playing field:** Reduced size, 18 × 10 meters; only the T-stick player may enter the goal area.
- **Goal conditions:** Goals may only be scored after crossing the center line.
- **Scoring:** Goals scored by the T-stick count as 2 goals during match play or 1 goal during penalties.
- **Maximum wheelchair speed:** Limited to 15 km/h.
- **Knockout matches:** In case of a draw, the match will go directly to penalties. In the bronze and gold medal finals, 2 × 2 minutes of extra time will be played before penalties.

The penalty format will be: 2 shots per team (first both H-stick players, then both T-stick players). If the tie remains, additional rounds will be played until a winner is determined.

- **Fair play and safety:** Sportsmanship, safety, and mutual respect will be prioritized

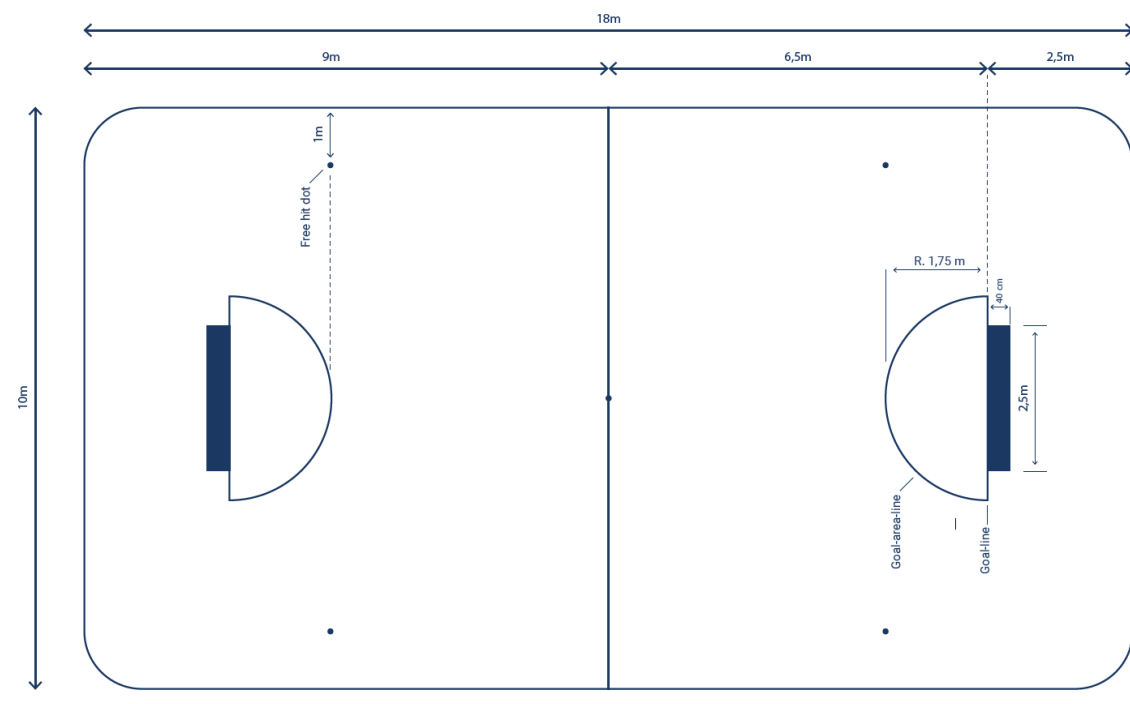

6. REGISTRATION

- **Registrarion opening date:** Monday, 19th January 2026
- **Registration closing date:** Monday, 2nd February 2026

8. TRANSPORT AND NEARBY AIRPORTS

Besalú is located in the province of Girona and is well connected by road.

Recommended airports:

- **Girona – Costa Brava Airport (GRO)**
Approximately 45 minutes by car.
- **Barcelona – El Prat Airport (BCN)**
Approximately 1 hour and 45 minutes by car

From both airports, Besalú can be reached by private transport or adapted vehicles.

The organization will provide information on accessible transport companies upon request if needed.

9. POWER WHEELCHAIR CHARGING

The sports hall will provide:

- Electrical outlets for charging power wheelchairs.
- The possibility of leaving wheelchairs charging overnight if required.

10. MEALS AND SERVICES

During the competition:

- **Saturday:** Lunch option available at the sports hall through a catering service.
- **Sunday:** Possibility of providing a picnic to take away after the competition.
- For other meals, efforts will be made to ensure that accommodation offers dinner options or that there are nearby restaurants accessible to athletes.
- Refreshments will be provided to athletes throughout the competition.
